Minutes of the Thirty-Second General Session

The Thirty-Second General Session of the First Constitutional Convention of the Territory of Guam convened at Convention Headquarters at 7:20 p.m., May 4, 1970. Mr. Antonio M. Palomo, President of the First Constitutional Convention, presided.

PRAYER

The Chaplain offered the following prayer:

"In the Name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit Amen. Let us pray...
