Dear Dr. Yamashita:

The Bill of Rights Committee of the First Constitutional Convention has been actively seeking the advice of interested citizens as it writes proposals for a new Bill of Rights.

Two issues which should concern educators are those of academic freedom and public aid to private education. These issues were discussed on September 4 and September 11 at meetings with representatives from the private and public school systems of Guam, respectively. Representatives from the public school system will be returning on September 18 to discuss the question of public aid to sectarian institutions, as time did not permit them to discuss this question at their last meeting.

The Bill of Rights Committee would like to invite representatives from the university community to contribute to this discussion. It will occur at 7:30 p.m. on September 18 at Convention Headquarters (second floor Peres Brothers Building, Agaña).

We will be looking forward to hearing contributions which the university may have to make.
