A PROPOSITION TO ADD A NEW SUB-SECTION (v) TO SECTION 5 OF THE ORGANIC ACT OF GUAM TO GUARANTEE TO THE PEOPLE OF GUAM THE RIGHT TO ORGANIZE AND BARGAIN COLLECTIVELY.

1 BE IT PROPOSED BY THE FIRST CONSTITUTIONAL CONVENTION
2 OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:
3 Section 1. Subsection (v) is hereby added to Section
4 of the Organic Act of Guam to read as follows:
5 " (v) The right of employees to organize and to
6 bargain collectively through representatives of their
7 own choosing is guaranteed. Labor organizations may
8 not strike if such would threaten the health or well-
9 being of the people of Guam. The legislature shall
10 provide a system of Workmen's Compensation and protec-
11 tion against the hazards of unemployment and disability,
12 and any against loss or inadequacy of income and
