Dear Carl,

Pursuant to the wishes of the Constitutional Convention, I am formally submitting my application to you for a position as full-time legal counsel, either to the Convention as a whole, or to several of the Committees of the Convention, such as the committees dealing with the Executive, Legislative, Judicial and Municipal Affairs. You already have my resume.

Based upon the assumption that the full-time position would be for a period of six months, I would seek compensation in the area of \$15,000, not including clerical and office expenses.

In addition to my resume, the following are pertinent:

A. I am admitted to the Bars of Guam, T.T.P.I, 9th Circuit Court of Appeals (Federal), U.S. Supreme Court and Illinois Supreme Court, and the District of Columbia Court of Appeals.

B. In addition to my academic training in Comparative and International Law, I have worked extensively, since coming to Guam, on Constitutional and Organic Act questions, both in public and private practice. I have thus had practical experience, both winning and losing, in the very issues which will be the subject of the Guam Constitution. For instance, one of the most litigated subjects on Guam concerns the various aspects of the Territorial Income Tax. The Convention must face the question of the continued taxation of the people of Guam, either by the "mirror image" of the Internal Revenue Code or by another system which will bring in equal, or additional, revenues.

C. I believe that I can best be of service to the Convention, not only with separate committees, but in assisting several committees in coordinating their efforts so that the various propositions presented to the Convention are presented as a system, i.e. after the formulation of a proposition for or concerning legislative matters, assuring that this proposition is reflected through the remainder of the Constitution. The Organic Act has failed to provide such unity, and has, because of it, created much litigation which would have been avoided under a well-drafted Constitution.

With the above in mind, please give this your most serious consideration.
