

One Guam

The project "One Guam" is spearheaded by the University of Guam Master of Public Administration in collaboration with other partners at UOG. One Guam will host one informational focus group with each of the individual task forces, and a gubernatorial debate on the topic of self-determination.

Focus Groups:

One Guam will invite each task force to participate in an individual focus group and discussion to gather research and develop topics for the debate.

Debate:

The debate is focused on Guam's political status and other matters related to self-determination. The event will be held on Tuesday, May 8, 2018, at 7:00 p.m. at the University of Guam Calvo Fieldhouse and will include all candidates vying for governor in the 2018 General Election. The debate will provide the gubernatorial candidates the opportunity to share with the people of Guam their ideas and beliefs on decolonization, thus help with the effort to bring the topics of self-determination to the forefront of the island community.
