17          (2) Public Information Program. The sum of *not less than* One  
18          Hundred Eighty Thousand Dollars (**\$180,000**) *shall* be allocated from the  
19          General Fund appropriation in Subsection (b)(1) for the *sole* purpose of  
20          conducting an extensive public education and information program by the  
21          COD and the Free Association, Independence, and Statehood Task Forces  
22          pursuant to § 2109, Chapter 21, Title 1 GCA. No funds allocated herein shall  
23          be expended for personnel or travel. The funds allocated in this Subsection  
24          *shall* be distributed as follows: Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000) to each Task  
25          Force in Fiscal Year 2019. Notwithstanding Chapter 5, Title 5 GCA or any  
26          other law, these funds *shall* be expended exclusively as advised by the Task  
27          Forces and approved by vote of the COD. A complete record of procurement

1 and expenditures *shall* be published on the COD's website within thirty (30)  
2 days after the end of each quarter.
